#### **About the Service**

The Westpac Rescue Helicopter Service (WRHS) is a registered Charity, or not-for-profit organisation. Our sole purpose is to provide the highest standard aeromedical response and search and rescue to the communities of Northern NSW. This service is provided 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, 365 days a year to anyone in need without anyone ever having to pay.

The Service's operational area extends from the Hawkesbury River in the south, to the Queensland border in the north and as far west as Brewarrina and Nyngan although further if tasked and operates from three bases across northern NSW, Newcastle, Tamworth and Lismore. Since March of 2015 when a Doctor and Paramedic have been on base 24 hours per day the Service now responds to over 1,500 life-saving missions each year.

# Drovers Run Early Bird 4WD Outback Adventure 2022

The Drover's Run Early Bird 4WD Outback Adventure will be held from the 1<sup>st</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> April, 2022. Until 2017 the Drover's Run had been a bi-annual event which in its first year in 2011 attracted 19 vehicles and raised \$60,000 for the Westpac Rescue Helicopter Service. In 2013 only nine vehicles took part but still an outstanding \$45,000 was raised for the Service. Our 2015 Drover's Run was an incredible success with over \$120,000 raised by the 25 vehicles that participated on an adventure that took entrants to Birdsville and back and in 2017 the 25 strong vehicle entry supported the Westpac Rescue Helicopter Service with almost \$140,000 raised by entrants and in 2019 a record 47 vehicles took part raising an astonishing \$250,000 A shorter one week Drover's in 2018 attracted twelve entrants who had never registered previously and resulted in a fantastic \$70,000 being raised.

Unfortunately the Drover's Run has been a victim of Covid-19 restrictions for the past two years so a successful 2022 event will be a welcome change and experience for our entrants.

We invite your business to be a Supporting Donor of the 2022 Drover's Run Early Bird Outback Adventure, and in turn, we will not only promote your business to the broader community during the event but you will also be assisting to save lives through your tax-deductible donation. The 2022 event will start in Narromine in Central West NSW with a get-together on Friday 1<sup>st</sup> April, then heading in to western NSW and then to the fabulous Murray River. We are again looking forward to the 2022 Drover's Run Early Bird raising a substantial amount of money for the Service and we look forward to you supporting this event.
