Today the Service delivers world class care for 1.5 million people from three bases in Belmont, Tamworth and Lismore.

Together, the highly trained Rescue Helicopter team is working to ensure the highest standard of care is provided for every patient at the scene of their accident.

It costs about \$40 million a year to keep the helicopters and crews ready to respond when needed. Every dollar we raise helps to keep the Rescue Helicopter flying 24-7 for those in need.

AW139 Fleet

Four AW139's cover 1.5m people throughout Northern New South Wales, from the Hawkesbury to the Queensland border, making it one of the leading aeromedical services in Australia.

The Rescue Helicopters operate from three bases at Belmont Airport, Lismore Airport and Tamworth Airport. Deep maintenance, engineering and administration are at Broadmeadow (Newcastle).

Our AW139 rescue helicopters which come with a price tag of approx \$18 million dollars each.

Features: Improved hoist, patient loading system and aircraft safety

Redundancy and backup: systems for avionics, hydraulics, fuel and electrical

The AW139's cost \$1000 per hour in fuel, \$1000 per hour to run the engine, \$1500 for the airframe and for \$500 avionics, that's a total of \$4000 per hour.

The AW139 helicopters are bigger aircraft capable of flying for longer, faster periods, covering great distances.

Missions

The service is on call 24 hours, seven days a week. Approaching 1,500 missions each year. In March 2020 the Lismore based Westpac Life Saver Rescue Helicopter has recently surpassed a significant milestone by flying its 10,000th mission.

Mission types include:

Primary – attend accident site, treat and transfer patients to hospital

Secondary – transfer patients between hospitals for specialist treatment

Search and rescue – help to locate missing people, rescue and return to safety

People

On board each helicopter is a crew of highly trained and skilled professionals.

The crew includes pilots, doctors, paramedics, nurses and rescue crew members depending on the needs of each patient.

Crews are supported by the work of engineering teams which include experienced planners and licensed aircraft maintenance engineers. Other important Service people are marketing and administration teams.
