



About the Service

The Westpac Rescue Helicopter Service (WRHS) is a registered Charity, providing the highest standard aeromedical response and search and rescue to the communities of Northern NSW. The service operates 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. The Service's operational area extends from the Hawkesbury River north to the Queensland border, and from the coast and as far west as we are tasked. The helicopters operate from three bases, Belmont, Tamworth and Lismore. The Service now responds to over 1,500 life-saving missions each year.

Drovers Run 4WD Outback Adventure 2 – 18 August 2024

The inaugural Drovers Run event took place in 2011, attracting 19 vehicles and raising \$60,000 for the Westpac Rescue Helicopter Service. The Drover's Run is now one of the biggest fundraising events for the Service. In 2022 after a three year Covid-enforced break, 34 vehicles travelled to Uluru and raised an astonishing \$225,000, and in 2023 twenty-seven vehicles travelled through Outback NSW and supported the work of the Westpac Rescue Helicopter Service with \$165,000 being raised. These results are directly due to the generosity of potential donors like yourself.
